4. Discuss and arrange company visits, mentorship, internship, job interview opportunities and other student engagement activities for all students and help to promote CLAP-TECH Pathway among interested students.
5. Establish a communication platform for constructive engagement of the key stakeholders to increase the awareness of CLAP-TECH Pathway and its related activities.
6. Collect relevant information to measure the effectiveness of the mentorship and internship experience for students and recommend measures for future improvement.
